Important Questions	Answers	Why This Matters:
What is the overall <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	Individual: \$3,500.00, Family: \$7,000.00	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan, each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible.
Are there services covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	Pharmacy: Generic drug (30 day supply), Generic drug (90 day supply), Non-Preferred drug (30 day supply), Non-Preferred drug (90 day supply), Specialty drug (30 day supply), Preferred drug (30 day supply), Preferred drug (90 day supply) Open Network: Many services. See the grid below for details.	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost-sharing and before you meet your deductible. Are there other <a href="#">deductibles</a> for specific services?	No.	You don't have to meet deductibles for specific services.
What is the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> for this <a href="#">plan</a> ?	Individual: \$7,350.00, Family: \$14,700.00	The out-of-pocket limit is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this plan, they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limits until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met.
What is not included in the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> ?	Premiums, pre-certification penalties, balance-billed charges, & health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit.
Will you pay less if you use a <a href="#">network provider</a> ?	You may pay less if you use a network provider.	
Do you need a <a href="#">referral</a> to see a <a href="#">specialist</a> ?	No.	You can see the specialist you choose without a referral.

**Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes**
